**SPECIFIC REGULATIONS**

## **ARTICLE 1 ORGANIZATION**

The 83rd Annual Holy Saturday Cross Country Cycle Classic is organized by the Belize Cycling Association under the regulations of the International Cycling Union and BCA. It is to be held on Saturday, 23<sup>rd</sup> April, 2011. The race will start at Old August Meat Shop, Mile 1 ½ Western Highway, Belize City at 6:00 a.m. travel to San Ignacio Town around Columbus Park and return to finish in front of the Memorial Park on Marine Parade in Belize City for a total of 142.4 miles.

## **ARTICLE 2 TYPE OF EVENT**

The event is open to athletes of the Under 23's, Elite and Masters Males categories. The event is entered on the BCA calendar.

The event is registered as a class HC event. In conformity with the UCI rules, points are awarded for the BCA ranking as follows:

## **ARTICLE 3 PARTICIPATION**

This event is open to a minimum of (4) and maximum of 10 riders per teams. Riders born 1993 and before will be allowed to participate. Registration for this event is Sixty Five Dollars (\$65.00) and Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for Race Radio.

### **Parade**

The annual parade of cyclists will be held on Thursday, April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2011 starting at 4:30 pm at the Court House Plaza. The route Regent Street, Albert Street, Albert Street West, Yarborough Road, Central American Blvd (entire length), Over Belcan Bridge, Round a bout, Princess Margaret Drive (entire length), Newtown Barracks, Marine Parade, Memorial Park (Finish Line for the race).

## **ARTICLE 4 RACE HEADQUARTERS**

The race headquarters of the race shall be open starting, Friday, April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2011 and located at the Civic Center, lower flat Belize City at which time team representative are requested to submit their list of titular riders.

Team representative will collect their technical vehicle caravan order and race numbers at the **Technical Meeting on Thursday, April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2011 – 7:00 pm at the Civic Center Conference Room, St. Jude Street, Belize City**. Only Team Manager will be allowed to attend this meeting. Verification of documents will be held from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Race Headquarters on the arrival site shall be open at 4 a.m. and located at the Old August Meat Shop, Mile 1 ½ Western Highway, Belize City.

**ARTICLE 5 RADIO TOUR**

Race information will be broadcast on the following frequency: 89.9 on the FM Band.

**ARTICLE 6 NEUTRAL TECHNICAL SUPPORTS**

The neutral technical support services handle by Belize Cycling Association. Drivers Messrs: Bruce Vergo and Kirk Sutherland, Mechanics: Messrs: Charles and Andrew Lewis, Harrison Arnold, and Cleon Broaster. The neutral support is taken care of by means of 2 pickup trucks providing wheel, and water.

**ARTICLE 7 FEEDING ZONE**

The feeding zone will be closed from the start of the event until Mile 31; however, riders will be allowed to drop back to their vehicle for refreshments after the first 15 miles. The zone will be opened after the completion of the first 30 miles into the race and will be closed at Mile 8.

**ARTICLE 8 FINISHING TIME LIMITS**

Any rider finishing in a time exceeding that of the winner by more than 45 minutes shall not be placed.

**ARTICLE 10 ANTI-DOPING**

The NADO anti-doping regulations are entirely applicable to the event. The Anti-doping tests will take place the Radisson Fort George Hotel, Fort Street.

The Anti-Doping Panel will inform the teams of persons to be tested. Each person to be tested needs one (1) representative to accompany them in the specimen booth. All riders who get summoned to be tested must present themselves at the specimen booth (30) thirty minutes after the completion of the event.

**Failure to comply will result in a NON-NEGATIVE test**

**ARTICLE 11 AWARDS CEREMONY**

**1.2.112** All riders concerned shall, in accordance with their placing, classifications and performances, participate in official ceremonies such as the presentation of jerseys, bouquets or medals, laps of honor, press conference and the like.

**1.2.113** Unless otherwise stated, riders shall appear at official ceremonies wearing competition clothing. In accordance with article 1.2.112 of the UCI rules, the following riders **must** attend the official awards ceremony:

- The first 3 of the event  
The riders will present themselves at the podium in a time limit of maximum 1 hour after crossing the finish line.

#### **ARTICLE 12 PENALTIES**

The UCI penalty scale is the only one applicable. (For other events)
